
Happy New Year! It promises to be a very exciting 2020 for Orion Harriers, with big news from the team working on the clubhouse extension below. First though, there are still some successes from 2019 to celebrate, starting with the resounding mob match win over SLH on 28th December. Well done to everyone who turned out to brave the mud and hills, and a huge thank you to all the volunteers who helped lay the trail, marshal and all the other crucial jobs to organise the race. Congratulations also to Brian Jenkins, who led Orion home with a storming run and looks to be on top form heading into the New Year.

There was also success at the start of the month with Orion retaining the Ware Cup at Loughton AC. George Day won the race, with Reece Barclay, Mike Roberts and Adam Baker also scoring to help secure the team win.

The third Essex Leaguer fixture of the season took place at Writtle in December and Orion's women's team put in their strongest performance so far to take second place and move up to joint-fourth in the overall standings. It was great to see Clare Thurgood back racing with a scorching run to finish fifth. The men's team was seventh at Writtle and are fifth overall, just one point behind Colchester Harriers. The next race is in Colchester on January 11th, more details below.

December also saw the fourth Chingford League race of the season at the Olympic Park. Orion's men were second and the women were third on the night, and both teams now sit second overall behind Victoria Park Harriers. The next race is on January 18th at Hackney Marshes.

In January we also have the Essex Senior XC Champs at Gloucester Park, Basildon on 4th January, and the Southern XC Champs at Parliament Hill on the 25th January. Best of luck to all who have signed up to race in either or both events!



Clubhouse Extension Update

We are very pleased to announce to members that we are finally in a position to start work on the clubhouse extension.

We have appointed local builders Barclay Brothers and the works are due to start on the 13th January and take about six months. We plan to minimise the disruption to the clubhouse during this period and will let you know if it is unavailable on any dates, for example when we knock through from the new build to the existing building.

As some of you know, the works will include a separate canteen for the golf club staff, for which the Corporation of London are obviously paying. This joint build means we are able to share some of the costs and reduce our contribution. We are funding the works through a grant of £95,000 from the London Marathon Charitable Trust and money we have raised and set aside from the Club's reserves which should amount to about £85,000. We have

managed to secure a rent-free deal on the extension for the first 21 years to offset our costs.
