

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

- Orion Harriers is committed to minimising our impact on the environment. We will achieve this through the objectives set out in this policy.
- Plastic water bottles will not be provided during or after races. Runners will be encouraged
 to bring their own reusable water bottles and we will make a water supply available for
 them to use.
- 3. Any single-use cups or plates that we supply will be biodegradable and, where possible, we will **recycle** any waste that we produce.
- 4. We will seek to provide vegetarian and **vegan alternatives** at club events.
- 5. We will monitor and seek to reduce energy consumption at our **club house**. Heating will be via a timer switch, for lighting we will use energy saving light bulbs and if maintenance or repairs are needed these will be carried out using environmentally responsible materials.
- 6. Unnecessary **printing** will be avoided. Minutes and agenda items will be circulated electronically.
- 7. We will, where possible, use **race numbers** that have been printed on recyclable or biodegradable material.
- Suppliers of kit, race t-shirts and club awards will be encouraged to reduce their environmental impact.
- 9. We will encourage our members to donate or **recycle clothing**, shoes and medals and supply details of organisations that help with this.
- 10. Car sharing to and from races is strongly encouraged and, where feasible, members will be encouraged to cycle or to use public **transport**.
- 11. "Plogging" helps to keep the forest clean. We will encourage our members to participate.
- 12. We will **raise awareness** of this environmental policy among our members and among the wider running community.
- 13. We will **review this policy** regularly and aim continually to improve our environmental performance as new initiatives and technological advances emerge.
