Chingford League Race #1 - Chingford Plains





After a long break, Chingford league returned to Chingford Plains on 24th October with this 5 miler designed by Paul Williams. An organised event that saw multiple pens employed to ensure social distancing was observed before the athletes were released in waves. The ladies were out first, with 20 white vests from Orion among them. Anna Louis and Ella Wilson were the first home for Orion, finishing within a stride of one another to take the 13th and 14th spots in a time of 35 minutes and 59 seconds. Roisin Archer was the third home for Orion in a time of 36 minutes and 2 seconds to take the 15th spot, with Hayley Rogerson finishing 20 seconds later. Christine Kennedy showed her class by coming in at 24th place, and the returning Louise Juby was the final scoring lady to finish the undulating course in 38 minutes and 31 seconds. The team put Orion into third place in the league, narrowly missed out on second spot. Well done to all the Orion Ladies who got out for this race, it was great to see such a strong Orion squad out there!

Next up was the Men's race. Nick Harris Fry was the first Harrier home to take 5th spot in a super strong line up in a time of 29 minutes and 10 seconds, with

Reece Barclay finishing 5 seconds later in another fine performance. Men's Road Champion George Day was third home to take 13th spot. Bob Glasgow was 4th home in a very decent time of 30 minutes and 12 seconds. Henry Giddens showed that he was still getting quicker and stronger by taking 15th spot in a time of 30 minutes 18 seconds. Mike Roberts completed the A-teams scoring by finishing in 17th spot. Will Reed-Wright was just outside the scoring team but ran such a fantastic race that he needed a mention. The team scored 49 points to cement the top spot in the Chingford League. Again it was great to see all the Orion Men get back to racing.

Chingford League Race #2 - Hog Hill





Ladies – A great turnout from our ladies for the hilly Hog Hill course that was in daylight, for the first time in the Chingford league. A fantastic win by Sophie Magson in her first race for the seniors saw her propel the ladies into third spot. Louise Juby was back in fine form after an injury hit year to take 14th spot overall in just under 21 minutes, with Hannah White and Roisin Archer both finishing shortly afterwards. Anna Louis was our 5th Harrier home and 1st V50 in 21:31 and Christine Kennedy as first V60 and the final scorer for the ladies team. The Ladies now sit at joint second place in the Chingford League. If we keep getting teams like this one out, we have a chance to win this league!

Well done to all our ladies.

Men – A great win by Nick Harris-Fry in our race at Chingford league helped the Orion Men take top spot at Hog Hill to hold onto the top spot in the Chingford league overall. NHF smashed out 16:38 with George Day chasing him down in 17:06 and Richard Smith coming into fine form with a 17:43 finish.

A great battle between Mick McTernan and Mike Roberts saw them push each to sprint up a brutal hilly finish. Evergreen Bob Glasgow ghosted his way through the second wave to take 5th spot, with Adam Baker being the final harrier home for the Men's A team. Great to have Donald Bennet run his first race for the club. Well done to the other Orion men who pushed themselves round that course.
